MEETING SUMMARY

- 1. **CALL TO ORDER AND SELF-INTRODUCTIONS** Lijin Sun, SCAG, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD** None.
- 3. CONSENT CALENDAR
 - 3.1. October 22, 2024 TCWG Meeting Minutes The meeting minutes were approved.

4. INFORMATION ITEMS

4.2. RTP Update

Agustin Barajas, SCAG, reported the following:

• 2025 FTIP and Connect SoCal 2024 Amendment 1, including the associated transportation conformity analysis, were expected to receive final federal approval in December 2024.

4.3. FTIP Update

Agustin Barajas, SCAG, reported the following:

- 2023 FTIP Amendment #23-37 was approved on November 22, 2024. 2023 FTIP Administrative Modification #23-28 was approved on November 25, 2024. These two amendments concluded all project revisions to the 2023 FTIP as SCAG transitioned to the 2025 FTIP.
- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-01 was expected to receive federal approval after the final federal approval of the 2025 FTIP.
- SCAG staff was preparing 2025 FTIP Administrative Modification #25-02 and Amendment #25-03, due to SCAG on January 14, 2025, to capture additional project updates between the federal approval of the 2025 FTIP and the federal approval of 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-01.

4.4. U.S. EPA Update

Michael Dorantes, U.S. EPA, reported no updates.

4.5. CARB Update

No representative was present to provide updates.



4.6. Air Districts Updates

4.6.1. Ventura County APCD Update Holly Galbreath, Ventura County APCD, reported no updates.

4.6.2. South Coast AQMD Update

Lijin Sun, SCAG, reported on behalf of South Coast AQMD:

- On November 25, 2024, U.S. EPA announced that the South Coast Air Basin had met the 2006 24-hour PM2.5 NAAQS, 35 ug/m³. South Coast AQMD would request U.S. EPA to redesignate the Basin to attainment and submit a maintenance plan in 2025. South Coast AQMD would work with staff from SCAG and CARB to develop motor vehicle emission budgets for transportation conformity to include in the maintenance plan.
- The Coachella Valley ozone nonattainment area met the 1997 8-hour ozone NAAQS, 80 ppb, in 2024. U.S. EPA was
 reviewing the South Coast's AQMD request to extend the attainment year to 2024. Upon U.S. EPA's approval,
 South Coast AQMD would request U.S. EPA to redesignate the area to attainment and submit a maintenance plan
 in 2025. South Coast AQMD would work with staff from SCAG and CARB to develop MVEBs for transportation
 conformity to include in the maintenance plan.

4.6.3. Mojave Desert AQMD Update

Alan De Salvio, Mojave Desert AQMD, reported no updates.

4.6.3.1. Status Update on the MDAQMD Lawsuit against EPA (Case No. 23-1411) Alan De Salvio, Mojave Desert AQMD, reported the following:

- The case was outstanding, and the related sanctions clocks were still pending.
- The Mojave Desert AQMD appealed the U.S. EPA's limited disapproval, which started the sanctions clocks. In September 2024, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit made a decision that was in favor of the Mojave Desert AQMD, and that the Mojave Desert AQMD's request to stay sanctions was deemed moot. The U.S. EPA had not taken formal action in response to the Court's decision.
- The Mojave Desert AQMD would seek an immediate injunctive relief with regards to the pending sanctions.

4.6.4. Antelope Valley AQMD Update

Barbara Lods, Antelope Valley AQMD, reported no updates.

4.6.4.1. Status Update on the AVAQMD Lawsuit against EPA (Case No. 23-1614) Barbara Lods, Antelope Valley AQMD, reported the following:

- Amendments to the Antelope Valley AQMD's new sources review (NSR) program Rules 1301, 1302, 1303, 1304, 1305, 1309 and a new Rule 1314 were noticed to the public on November 29, 2024.
- The NSR Rules Package would be presented to the Antelope Valley AQMD Governing Board for adoption at the December 30, 2024 Governing Board meeting and subsequent submittal to U.S. EPA through CARB.
- Amendments to the Antelope Valley AQMD's NSR Rules were expected to be approvable by U.S. EPA to address the active sanctions clocks.

4.6.5. Imperial County APCD Update

No representative was present to provide updates.
